

Housing tips (according to MSM students)

Tips current students for future student

- If you are second guessing renting your room/apartment from your home country then book the Aparthotel for 1 to 3 months or stay at an Airbnb and find housing while you are in Maastricht.
- Contact a real estate broker and tell him exactly what you are looking for.
- Start looking for housing as soon as possible.
- As of January (mid of the academic year) you can change housing as a lot of options open up again.
- Do research about housing on social media platforms.
- Do a viewing and if you are not able to do this yourself ask the landlord to give you a viewing via skype or ask a friend/current student in Maastricht to help you out.
- Get in contact with fellow students and find housing together.
- Find an accommodation where gas, electricity, water and internet is included in the rental price.
- Do not trust landlords that ask for an obscene amount or a lot of months' rent up front as a deposit.
- Keep your accommodation in good condition so that a property owner does not have the excuse to charge you for repairs or can refuse to give back your deposit.
